I can show pictures of and be able to talk about different types of flying machines. The Scout will have researched the subject and be able to present pictures of different craft. He/she will be able to discuss each craft and describe why it is different.
I can build a paper airplane from an A4 sheet that will fly, climb and turn. The Scout should be given a number of A4 sheets and asked to make a number of paper planes. These can be tested and the best one used for demonstration.
I can discuss the features of an airport from a model or picture (Runway, Terminal, Control Tower). The Scout will be able to discuss the layout of an airport with reference to a picture or map. He / she should be able to point out the runway, terminal, control tower etc.
I know how to be safe around aircraft. The Scout should show an awareness of the dangers of an airfield and around an aircraft. The Scout should be particularly aware that they should follow instructions carefully and be aware of their surrounding at all time.
